Setup and Services

The Henry Ford provides the following foundation items for your event:

- Guest tables are 8-foot wooden tables, with or without white linen. Two hurricane lamps for each table. Table numbers available upon request.
- Historic-inspired wood ladder-back and cane chairs seat up to 8 guests per table (alternate chairs not available with this venue).
- Classic white china, bar/stemware and flatware.
- Eagle Tavern dinner menu includes historic transferware (china), pottery service items and staff in 1850s period clothing.
- High cocktail tables with white floor-length linen and three votives are included, as fitting, with receptions.
- Tables (8 feet long), with or without white linen, are available for items such as favors, escort cards, DJ.

- Add a fire to Eagle Tavern bar fireplace November-April for a \$250 fire specialist fee.
