



Helpful Tips and Accessibility Information

We look forward to welcoming you to World Tournament of Historic Base Ball in Greenfield Village. Please read the important information below carefully for the best experience.

» Drop-Off and Pickup

For guests with mobility limitations, there is a drop-off and pickup area in front of the Greenfield Village ticket building.

» Wheelchairs and Motorized Scooters

You are welcome to bring your own wheelchair or motorized scooter. A limited number of wheelchairs and motorized scooters are available to rent at the Greenfield Village ticket building. Wheelchairs are \$4 for the entire day and scooters are \$25 per day. To rent a wheelchair or scooter, guests are asked to speak with a staff member in the Guest Services Office of the Greenfield Village ticket building to complete a rental agreement form. Please note that motorized scooters rent out quickly and may not be available. We do not take advance reservations for wheelchairs or motorized scooters.

» Wagons, Strollers and Segways

You are welcome to bring your own wagons and strollers. Children's wagons are available to rent on a first-come, first-served basis for \$5 per day at the Greenfield Village ticket building. Segway scooters are permitted for use only by guests with mobility limitations and must be brought by the guest.

» Please be aware that World Tournament of Historic Base Ball includes the following:

- A distance of 1/2 mile from the entrance gates of Greenfield Village to the location of the historic base ball games (Walnut Grove). If needed, please have other forms of transportation (i.e., strollers, wagons, wheelchairs) available.
- Areas of uneven terrain off of paved pathways
- Crowds
