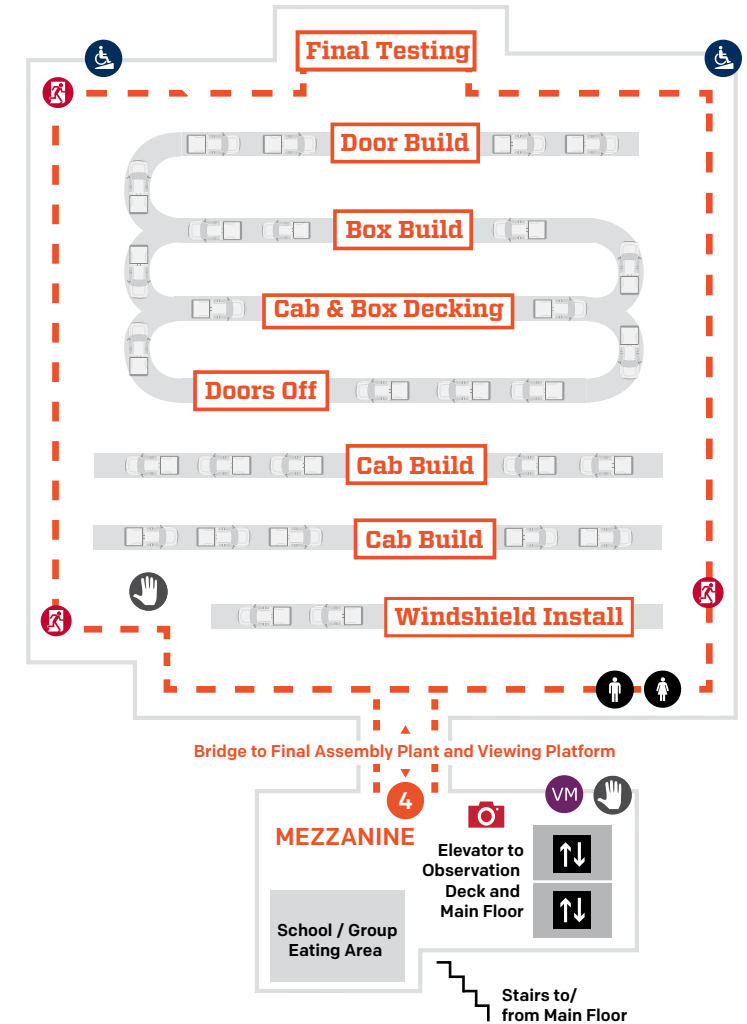
FIRST FLOOR / MAIN FLOOR
