Helpful Tips and Accessibility Information

Tips

- ▶ Warm clothing and footwear are recommended, as you will be outside most of the evening.
- ▶ The Holiday Nights program takes place after sunset. The street lamps of Greenfield Village will be lit, but do take care and watch your step.
- ▶ Please note that the Donald F. Kosch Village Playground will not be open during this event.

Drop-Off and Pickup

For guests with mobility limitations, there is a drop-off and pickup area in front of the Greenfield Village ticket building.

Wheelchairs and Motorized Scooters

A limited number of complimentary wheelchairs are available at the Greenfield Village ticket building for this event. Guests are asked to leave a driver's license with the staff member in the Guest Services Office of the Greenfield Village Ticket Building in order to rent a wheelchair. You are welcome to bring your own motorized scooter. However, because of space and safety issues, scooters are not available to rent for this event.

Wagons, Strollers and Segways

You are welcome to bring your own wagons and strollers. However, they will not be available to rent for this event. Segway scooters are not permitted in any venue of The Henry Ford.

Please be aware that Holiday Nights in Greenfield Village includes the following:

- ▶ Dark environments with areas of uneven terrain. Please bring a flashlight if you feel it will assist you in navigating the event.
- ▶ Crowds
- ▶ Wood smoke and open flame
- ▶ Fireworks
- ▶ A possibility of ice and/or snow on walkways
