Set-Up and Services

The Henry Ford provides the following foundation items for your event:

- Set-up based on service style.
- 60-inch round tables with white floor-length linen set for 8 guests for plated or buffet dinners.
- Mixed seating, including high and low cocktail tables and 60-inch round tables, for strolling dinners.
- Classic white china, bar/stemware and flatware; optional hurricane lamp and table numbers.
- Large group events may be required to use environmentally friendly high-end disposables.
- Mahogany Chiavari chairs with matching brown pad.
- Auxiliary tables (6 or 8 feet long) with white or black floor-length linen are available for registration, name tags, awards and display tables. Up to 10 available at no additional cost.
- Custom diagram of event set-up and design, including online collaboration tool for seating.
- Museum Plaza Innovation Columns have over 30 complimentary images available for your event to be used as a decor element. Optional add-on to highlight your brand or event with custom images, logos and photos: \$250 for the first custom image, \$100 for each additional image.
