## **Hallowe'en in Greenfield Village Helpful Tips and Accessibility Information**

- Jack-o'-lanterns do not emit a great deal of light, so it will be rather dark.
- Comfortable footwear is recommended.
- Our costumed characters are both friendly and scary, so please be prepared.
- Please arrive as close to your ticketed time as possible. Early entry will not be allowed. Late arrivals will be accommodated up to 30 minutes beyond the time stated on your ticket. We cannot guarantee late entry beyond 30 minutes for last scheduled entry time of the evening.
- Join the fun and wear your own Hallowe'en costume! But remember, swords, other weapons, sharp instruments and firearms, real or imitation, are not allowed. These will be collected at the entrance for your pickup at the end of the evening. It's also a good idea not to wear large masks or headgear that may impede your vision.
- Please note that the Donald F. Kosch Village Playground will not be open during this event.

### **Drop-Off and Pick-Up**

For guests with mobility limitations, there is a drop-off and pick-up area in front of the Greenfield Village ticket building.

### **Wheelchairs and Motorized Scooters**

A limited number of complimentary wheelchairs are available at the Greenfield Village ticket building for this event. To rent a wheelchair, guests are asked to leave a driver's license with the staff member in the Guest Services Office of the Greenfield Village ticket building. You are welcome to bring your own motorized scooter. However, because of space and safety issues, scooters are not available to rent for this event.

### **Wagons, Strollers and Segways**

You are welcome to bring your own wagons and strollers. However, they will not be available to rent for this event. Segway scooters are permitted for use only by guests with mobility limitations and must be brought by the guest.

### **Please be aware that Hallowe'en in Greenfield Village includes the following:**

- Use of strobe lights and other repeating light features
- Use of simulated fog and smoke through water-based propylene glycol fog fluid
- Use of laser projectors and laser displays
- Sudden loud noises and "startles"
- Wood smoke and open flame
- Dark environments with areas of uneven terrain. You may bring a flashlight.
- A set path that guests are restricted to and the possibility of waiting in lines. If you need to leave a line or diverge from the path at any time, please ask a staff member for assistance.
- Treats that may contain or have come in contact with common food allergens, such as peanuts, wheat and dairy.
